- Partnership with the Census Bureau to:
 - Deliver accurate and timely access to U.S. Census data and products
 - Prepare and provide training and technical assistance to data users
 - Assist and communicate with the Census Bureau on data usability, data user needs, and operational issues

New Mexico SDC Network



- Lead organization – NM Economic Development Department (NM EDD)
- Over 20 coordinating agencies and affiliates
 - UNM Bureau of Business and Economic Research (UNM BBER)

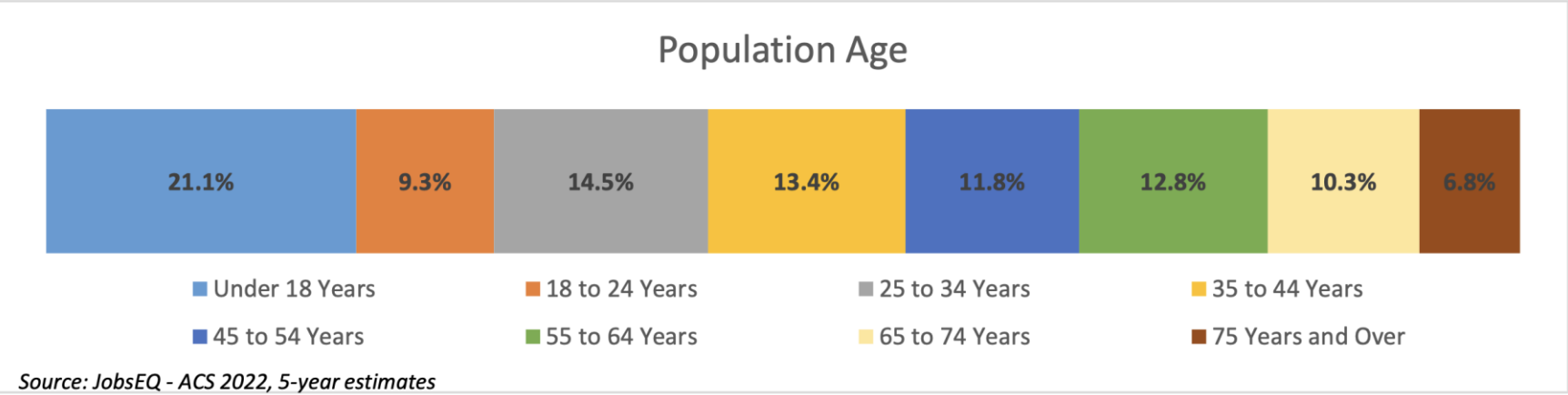
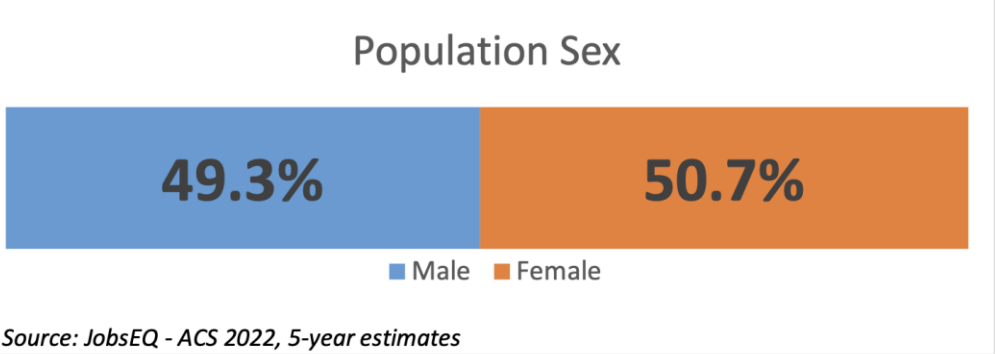


Quarterly Economic Summary Bernalillo County
